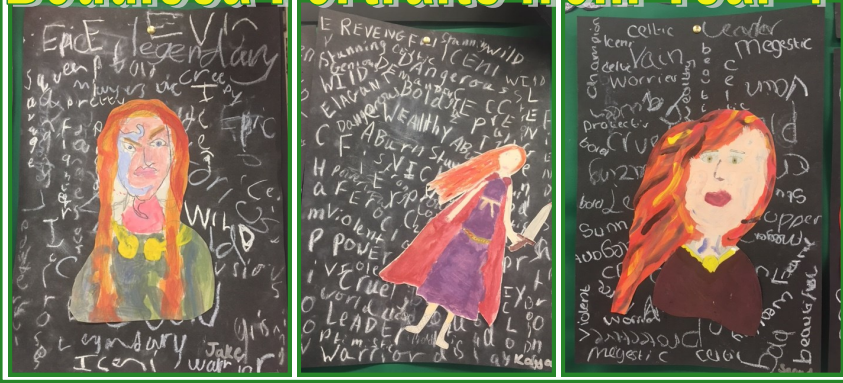

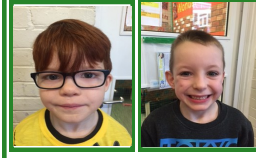


### HOUR OF CODE

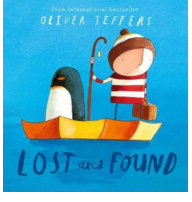

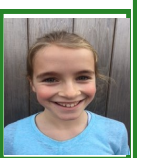


## Lenny and Sadie's Roman Rhyme!
