## Message from the head

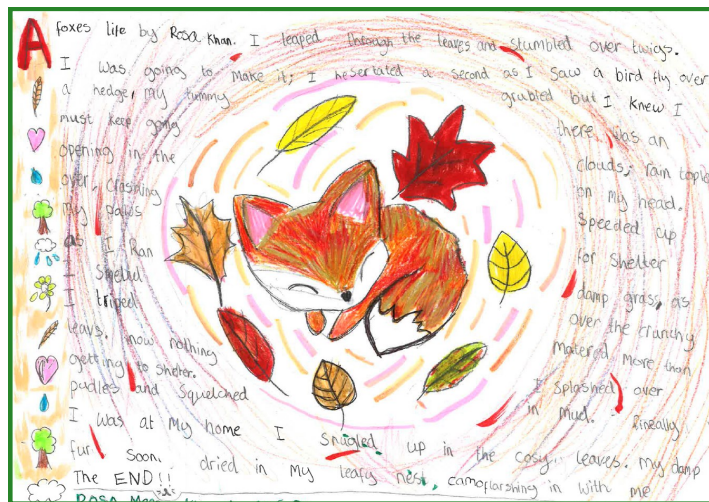
