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We recently took receipt of an Automatic External Defibrillator (or AED) thanks to some funding from 'Hand on Heart'. This week, we were visited by a First Aid trainer, who trained all of our Year 5 children in basic CPR and how to use the AED. We then had a training session for some of our staff. We hope we will never have to use it, but if we do we are prepared. Basic life saving training is a fantastic life skill and can make all the difference in an emergency. We hope to make this part of our curriculum moving forward with all Year 5's receiving the training each year. A massive thank you to 'Hand on Heart' for providing the AED and the training. Also to Sam (parent and ex-governor) for putting us in touch with them.
