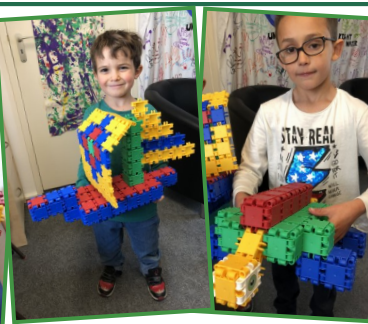

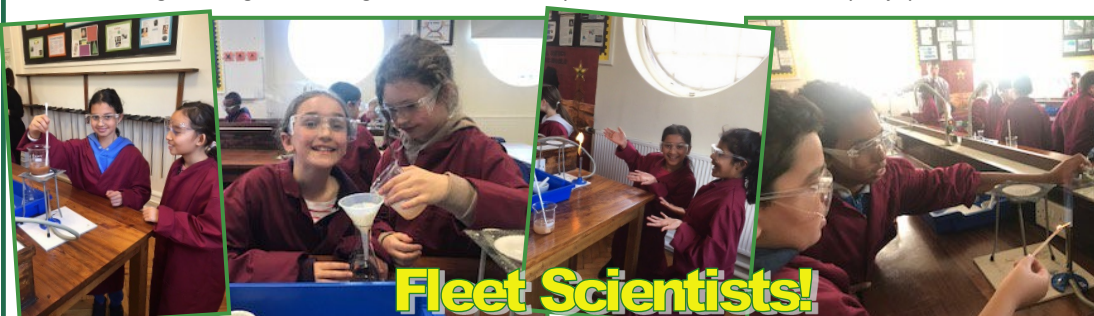


## Master Builders!
