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Road safety scheme consultation

This week we received a copy of a consultation from the council. It concerned proposed changes to the roads and junctions around school—specifically the Cressy Road, Lawn Road and Parkhill Road junctions with Fleet Road as well as the Fleet Road/Southampton Road/Agincourt Road Junction. These changes are aimed at reducing congestion and improving streets for walking and cycling. One of the proposals in the consultation is to change the single yellow line outside of school to double yellow to stop people parking here and causing congestion to build up. We have submitted a response from school to the proposals.
