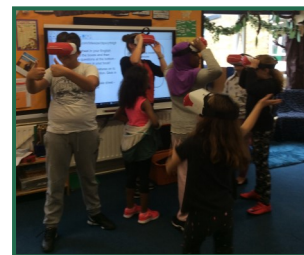


Message from the head

School Opening Times

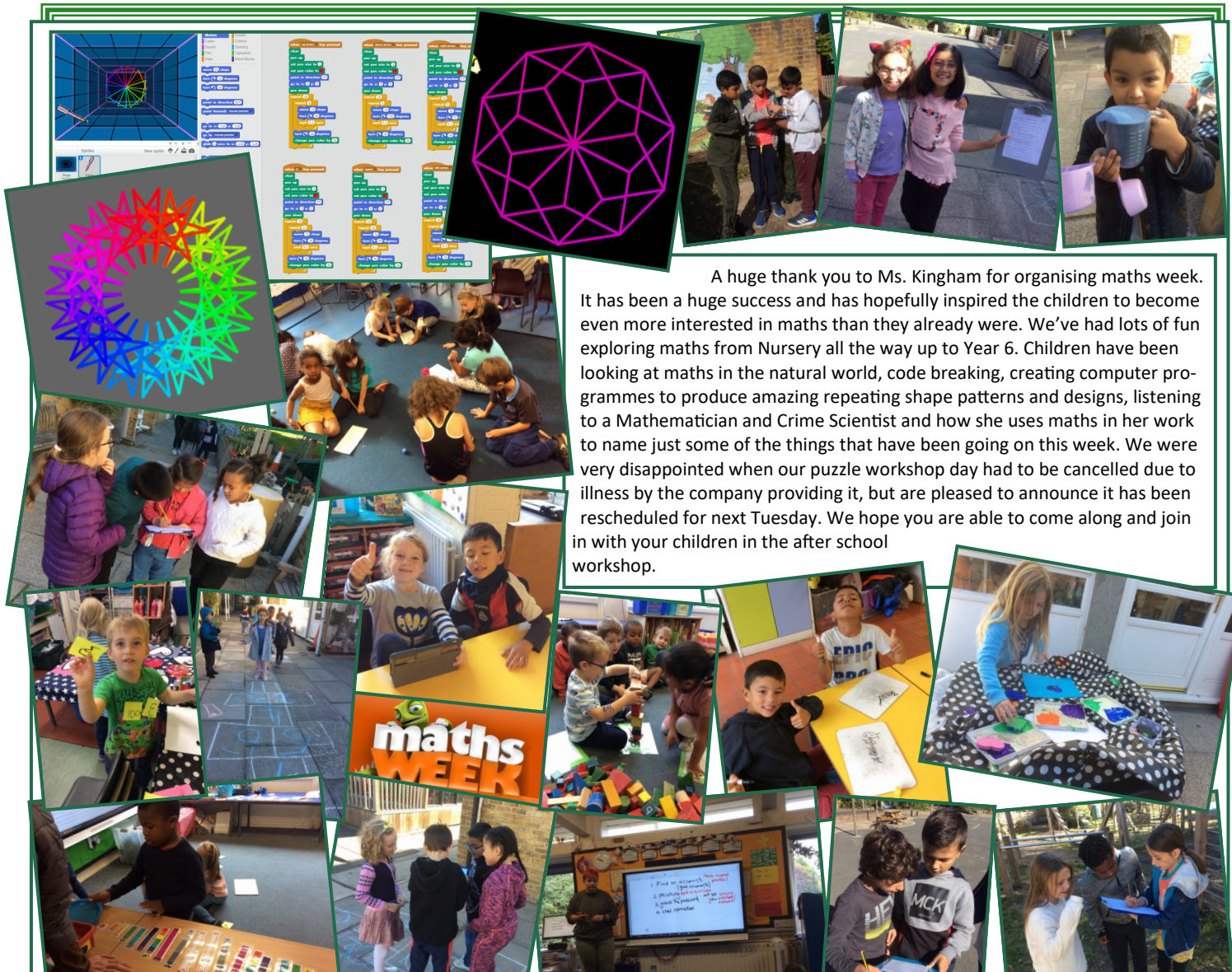
