Our attendance award for this week goes to Year3 with 97% attendance. Well done to them but we're sure we can do much better next week.

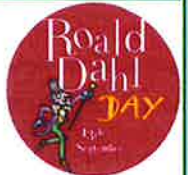


## Meet the Parents Event—19th Sept
