## End of Term Message from Fleet

Dear Parents and carers,

I wanted to send one last message this academic year to wish you all a wonderful summer. This has been a trying time for us all. Many of you may have experienced loss of one kind or another, Covid related or not, restrictions have meant that usual support networks have not been there to lean on and support us. The loss of social contact with friends and family has been hard.
