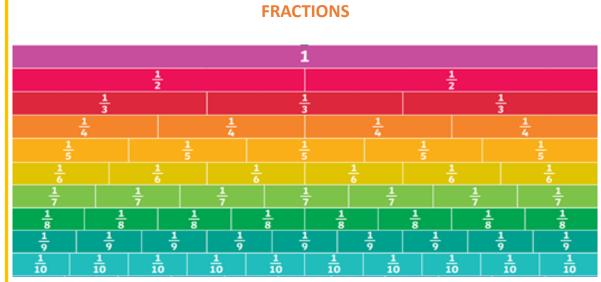


MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISION						
The 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 times tables!						
Related division facts—the inverse						
E.g. 3 x 4 = 12 so 12 ÷ 4 = 3						
Understand that multiplication is commuta- tive						
E.g. 4 x 8 = 8 x 4						
Use the grid method to multiply						
E.g. 14 x 3						
	x	10	4			
	3	30	12			

So 14 x 3 = 30 + 12 = 42

## 1, 10s, 100s

Add and subtract 1s, 10s/100s without difficulty.

E.g. 273 + 1 = 274, 273 + 10 = 284,

273 + 100 = 373
