Key Vocabulary

- City A large area where lots of people live.
- Landmark An object or a feature that has importance or makes a
 place easy to recognise.
- Map A picture of a place that shows us where we are and how to get somewhere else.
- Ocean A big body of salt water.
- Equator An imaginary line around the middle of a planet dividing it into northern and southern hemispheres.
- North and South Poles The northern most and southern points of the Earth.
- Climate The general weather conditions in an area.

Phonics Key Vocabulary

- **Phoneme** The sound the letter or group of letters makes.
- Grapheme A letter or group of letters used to represent a phoneme. The sound written down.
- Digraph Two letters to represent one phoneme. With children, we frequently reinforce it with the mantra, two letters, one sound.
- Trigraph Three letters to represent one phoneme, three letters, one sound.
- Blend To combine individual phonemes into a whole word, working all the way through from left to right. When reading we say, 'point and sweep'. The children point to each grapheme and blend them to read the word.
