The prime areas of learning that take priority when planning are:

- Communication and Language
- Personal, Social and Emotional Development
- Physical Development

Specific areas include:

- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding of the World
- Expressive Arts and Design

Once the children are all full time, will have 3 carpet sessions a day, each with a specific focus. Our first session beginning at 9am, will have a topic focus and will engage the children in the exciting learning opportunities for the day. During the day we will also have a Mathematics and Literacy focused session. The carpet session after lunch will also be a chance for the children to have a little rest and some quiet time before getting involved with the afternoon's activities.

As the year goes on, our involvement with the main school will increase with us going over for a PE session, attending singing assemblies, as well as watching class assemblies and working on cooperative projects with older children.

Autumn Term Topic – Marvelous Me and My Family Tree

The focus for our topic this term is supporting the children to settle into nursery away from their families. We will also be focusing on supporting the children to develop positive relationships enabling them to build new friendships with all the other children in nursery and learning to see themselves as part of a class. We have chosen lots of lovely books that we will use as a weekly focus help to bring the topic to life. We will also be looking at different family events and celebrations including Halloween, Diwali and Christmas. We are very excited about this topic and hope the children will be too.

Snacks and Lunch

Please send your child to school each day with a named water bottle so they can drink throughout the day. We ask that the bottles are filled with **water only** – no squash, carbonated water or juice please. This is in line with our Healthy School policy.

A variety of fruit snacks are provided for the children to eat each morning. Lunch is a social time in our Nursery, with staff supporting the children. This is also a time for us to teach about hygiene and healthy eating. You will receive a menu each term, detailing the different meal plans. We do encourage the children to try new foods and aim to make lunchtimes a positive experience but there may be times your child hasn't had a lot to eat. If this is the case, we will let you know.

Reading

One of the best things you can do for your child is read to them. The children will have the opportunity to select books to take home and share with you at home. To help look after our books, we would be grateful if you could buy a Fleet book bag from Nursery or the office for £3.50. The children can take home 2 books at a time. Our Book Bag changing days are Tuesday and Thursday. We also read to the children throughout the day and encourage their participation in retelling stories and joining in wherever possible.

Mathematics

Many of our rhymes will have a number focus and we will do a lot of number work around these. Practical mathematics activities will also be embedded in our activities throughout the day. We will continually give the children reasons to count, sort, order, sequence and recognise numerals. The children will also participate in maths games and puzzles in an adult led group. Our carpet sessions will have different focuses such as reciting numbers, representing numbers, discussing number names and matching numerals to quantities. Once all the children are settled, we will introduce a number of the week. There will be lots of number activities to support this in nursery and we will provide ideas for activities so that you'll be able to join in with this at home too.

Clothing

Please dress your child in clothes that allow for their growing independence. Unless your child can fasten their own shoelaces, please send them in shoes or boots with velcro or zips that will help to support their growing independence.

Due to the nature of early years education, there will be times when the children get dirty, even with aprons on. For this reason, please avoid sending your child to school in special clothing. Additionally, please ensure there are spare clothes for your child and replace items as they are used.

All Weather Nursery

We are an all weather nursery, so the children will play outside in different kinds of weather. Please send your child in with a named, preferably waterproof, coat with a hood, as well as

winter clothing when the weather is cooler. It's also very helpful if hats, gloves etc are named too. We also ask that a pair of named wellington boots are left at school for the children to wear for Forest School sessions. More details to follow separately about these sessions.

Camden Kids Talk

This year we are delighted to be taking part in the Camden Kids Talk project. This is a multi-agency approach to improving communication, speech and language in the early years. There will be more information about this and 2 parent sessions later in the year.
