- Write their name, using capitals in the correct places.
- Get dressed independently.
- Put on their jacket and zip or button it up.
- Get book bag ready for school and gather their own belongings.
- Enjoy lots of stories together!
Predict what might happen next in the story
Reread favourite stories again and again
Retell stories through play. *Once upon a time...*
Encourage children to listen out for rhyming words in stories you read to them. Julia

Donaldson stories are great for this.

Go for treasure hunts through a story looking for different letters.

- Encourage your children to write in meaningful ways such as making shopping lists, birthday cards and thank you letters.
- Remind your child to share and wait for their turn nicely. If they are the only child at home, perhaps they can practise turn taking with you.
- Lots of praise when they have successfully managed a delay for things they have asked for.
- Count to 10, then 20.
Count objects one at a time.
Look for and recognise numbers in the environment.
- Continue to develop and celebrate their own interests.
