**Micro-habitat** - a very small habitat (for example, under a stone)

**Nutrient** - a substance that provides nourishment essential for the maintenance of life and for growth.

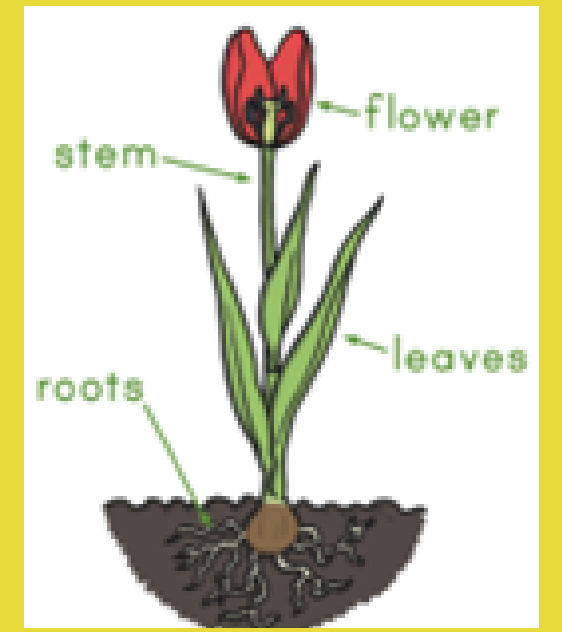
**Urban** - in a city or town
