Habitat - a natural home for plants and animals

Micro-habitat - a very small habitat (for example, under a stone)

Nutrient - a substance that provides nourishment essential for the maintenance of life and for growth.

Urban - in a city or town

Woodland - land covered in trees

Germinate—begin to grow and put out shoots

Seed dispersal—the movement or transport of seeds to new sites for germination
