
Elizabeth I (1533-1603)

A social and environmental Activist.



Charles Dickens (1812– 1870)

Zaha Hadid (1950-2016)

An architect, known for designing buildings with curved shapes.



Marcus Rashford (1997)

A professional footballer and activist.



Elizabeth Blackwell (1821-1910)

A physician (medical doctor), and the first woman to earn a medical degree in the United States.



Matthew Henson (1866-1955)

An explorer who went on voyages to the Arctic.



Yayoi Kusama (1927)

A contemporary artist famous for her polka dots.
