

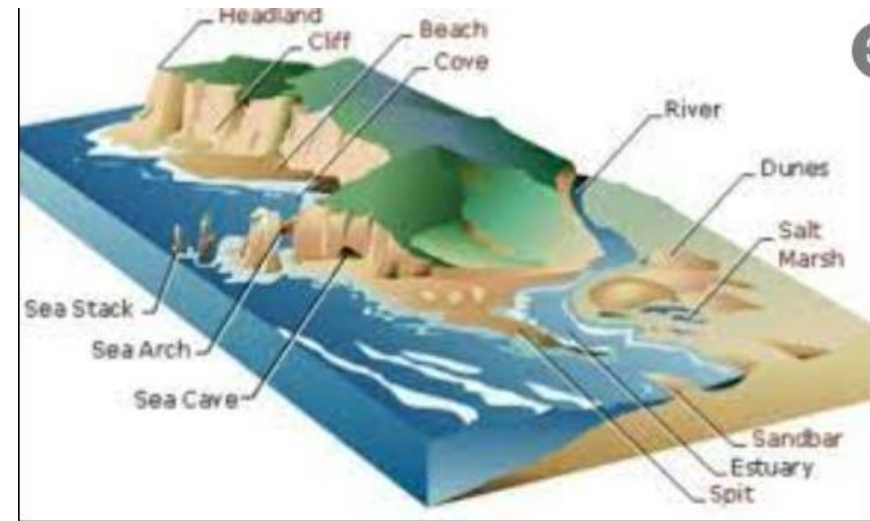

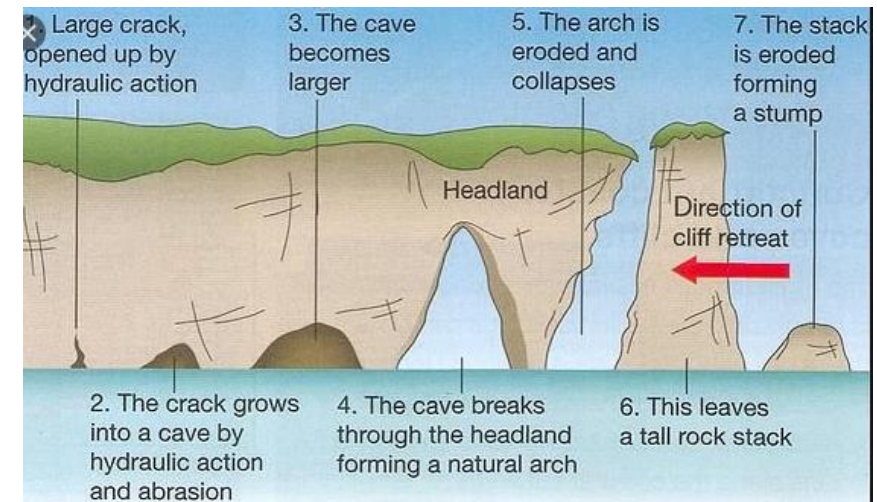
- 1.) **Erosion**- is a process where natural forces like water, wind, ice, and gravity wear away rocks and soil.
- 2.) **Coastal**- where the sea and land meet. Coastal areas are also known as shores and seashores.
- 3.) **Region**- a specific area that has common features.
- 4.) **Classification**- a system used to describe and organise organisms into groups.
- 5.) **Organism**- a living thing made up of one or more cells and able to carry on the activities of life (using energy, growing, or reproducing).
- 6.) **Microorganism**- tiny forms of life that include bacteria, algae, fungi, protozoa, and viruses.
- 7.) **Flora**- the plants of a particular region.
- 8.) **Fauna**- the animals of a particular region.
- 9.) **Conservation**- preservation or protection of something.
- 10.) **Endangered**- close to extinction.
