Microorganism- tiny forms of life that include bacteria, algae, fungi, protozoa, and viruses

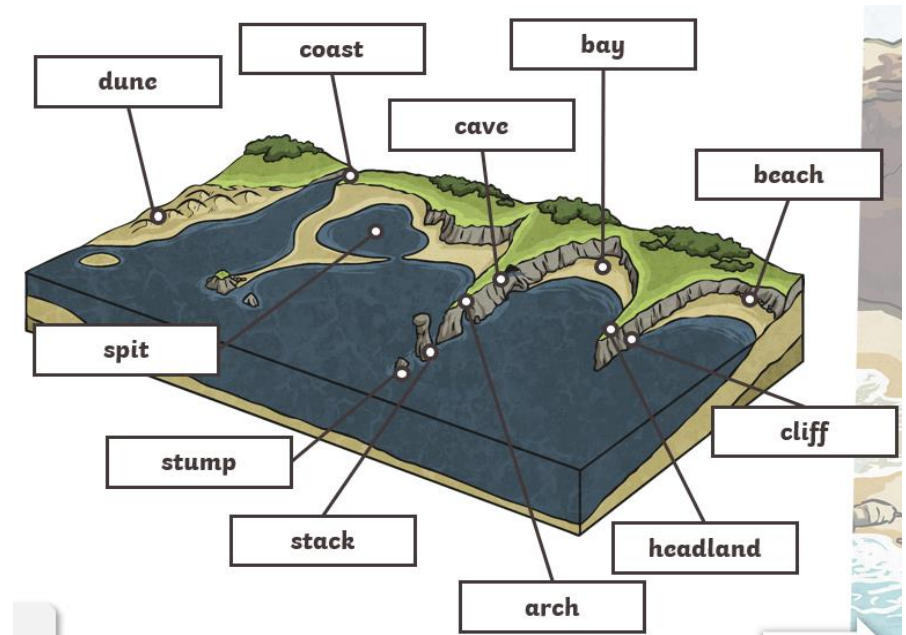
Flora- the plants of a particular region
