2. **City** - A large area where lots of people live.



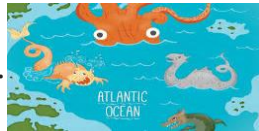
3. **Landmark** - An object or a feature that has importance or makes a place easy to recognise.

Key Figure: Charles Darwin



Charles Darwin (1809-1882) was a famous English Scientist and Adventurer. He sailed to many countries on a ship called HMS Beagle learning about living things.
