Key Vocab

Inca Empire: A 13th century civilization located around the Andean mountain range in South America.

Macchu Picchu: 15th Century Inca site in Peru.

Tropical Rainforest: Dense, warm, wet forests where temperatures and rainfall are very high all year round.

Deforestation: Removal of a forest so that the land on which it stood can be put to another use.

Conservation: prevention of wasteful use of a resource.

Continent: any of the world's main continuous expanses of land (Europe, Asia, Africa, North and South America, Australia, Antarctica).
