
Overview

- 1. China is a country in East Asia.
- 2. It is the world's most populous country, with a population of approx 1.4 billion in 2020.
- 3. Its currency is Renminbi.
- 4. Chinese dragons are powerful symbols in Chinese culture.
- 5. China has several active volcanoes, including:
 - o Changbaisan
 - o Jingbo
 - o Wudalianchi
- 6. It also experiences earthquakes.
- 7. China has four seasons. The Chinese climate varies from region to region since the country is massive!

Volcanoes

- 1. A **volcano** is a mountain or hill, typically conical, having a crater or vent through which lava, rock fragments, hot vapour, and gas are or have been erupted from the earth's crust
- 2. Geologists classify volcanoes into three types: composite volcanoes, cinder cone volcanoes and shield volcanoes.

Earthquakes



- 1. An earthquake is a sudden violent shaking of the ground.
- 2. **Tectonic plates** are pieces of the earth's crust and upper mantle. Earthquakes usually occur on **plate boundaries**.
- 3. Earthquakes are measured on the Richter scale.
