



Topic - Things we Love!





This week's activity ideas...

Personal, Social and Emotional Development



Listen to My Many Coloured Days on the Nursery page. This story talks about how our feelings are like colours. Sometimes we feel excited and happy, sometimes we feel sad, sometimes angry. There are many ways to feel and all are ok. Talk about the different colours and different feelings in the story. How are you feeling today? What colour are you?

Talk to your family about how they are feeling too. Maybe you could think of something to do for someone that isn't feeling so happy today?


Play I spy with colours as a family!

Physical Development

In the story Pinkalicious, they make yummy cupcakes that turn people pink! (an you make some cupcakes at home? Have a go at mixing the ingredients together with a spoon. There is a recipe here for easy cupcakes https://www.bbcgoodfood.com/recipes/cupcakes



Make some paper chains. (ut strips of paper, old magazines or newspaper. Glue one into a circle, then thread the next strip through the circle and glue the ends of this together. Now you have the beginning of a chain. Keep going until your chain is as long as you want. You could try and make a repeating pattern in your chain e'g' blue, red, blue, red.



Carry on practising your cutting skills at home remember the rhyme to help you hold the
scissors correctly - 'Fingers on the bottom and
the thumb on top, open the mouth and go chop, chop, chop!'

Practise your ball skills if you can. (an you throw and catch a ball? (an you roll the ball to someone in your family? (an you kick it to them? If you want some tips, watch Footy Pups here... https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b072vz79/footy-pups-series-1-21-throwing

Listen to and watch some colour stories on the Nursery page. In the stories you can see lots of colours. Which colour is your favourite? Could you make up a story about colours?


Draw pictures of your favourite parts of the stories and send us a photo - we would love to see them!

Phonics

Parents, if your child is confident with the sounds we have learned so far (s,a,t,p,i,n,m,d, g, o, c, k, e) you could show them how there are words they can build with these sounds eg s-a-t, t-a-p, m-a-n, d-i-p, p-i-n, etc Make a set of sound cards and see if you can move them around to make some words. Remember to keep adding the new sound each week!

Writing



Have a go at some rainbow writing. You could practise letter shapes, write your name or draw some pictures. Keep going over your lines in different colours to make your rainbow.

Remember to be mark making lots at home - help with shopping lists, making cards, writing your name on any pictures you do. Writing your own name is such a fantastic thing to be able to do so keep practising!

Practice your new sound - watch the video on the nursery page to help you. Say the rhyme

while you have a go.

'Lift off the top and scoop out the egg.'

Can you make a rainbow for your name?

Don't forget to look at the nursery sounds and letter formation document that has all the sounds we have learnt so far


Shapes and Patterns

We know the names of some 2D shapes. Now we are going to learn some 3D shape names.

This week we are going to learn about a cube. A cube is a box shape. Each side is the same size.

Can you find anything that is a cube in your house?

We have learned lots of shapes in the past few weeks - triangle, square, circle and rectangle. Are you ready to learn some names of tricky shapes? Watch this song and see if you can remember the name for a five sided shape? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WTeq Uejf3D0

This week we are thinking about patterns. A pattern repeats so you can see the same thing happening over and over. You can make patterns in lots of ways. You can make a pattern of actions - jump, hop, jump, hop, jump, hop. You can make a colour pattern - red, green, yellow, red, green, yellow. You can make a pattern of animals - dog, cat, dog, cat, dog, cat. You can make a pattern of anything!

Have a go at making your own patterns this week. Take a photo and email it to school so we can see them please?







Understanding the World

Expressive Arts and Design


Can you learn the colours of the rainbow in order? This song will help! Meet Roy.G.Biv...

Colour mixing is great fun. If you have paints at home, try making some new colours. It can be quite exciting to see the different colours and shades you can create as you mix.



Colour mixing can also be done in a sealable bag - less clearing up afterwards!



Colour some tube shaped pasta by squeezing some paint into a sealable bag. Add some pasta, close the bag and

shake! Pour the coloured pasta out to dry and then get creating beautiful necklaces and bracelets by threading the pasta on to string. You could even make patterns! (hopped up plastic straws can also be good for this activity.



Make rainbows in lots of ways...









If you make a circle of Skittles sweets on a flat plate and add warm water, you get a wonderful rainbow appear as if by magic! Lots of fun!


