Personal, Social and Emotional Development

You may have noticed rainbows appearing in the windows around your home. People are drawing and painting rainbows to make everyone feel happier while we can't go outside much. Can you draw or paint a rainbow for your window?

Physical Development

Can you practise your cutting skills? Use old magazines and things that people are finished with to cut out shapes and pictures you like. Make a funny picture or a funny face.

Health and Self Care

Can you practise getting dressed in the morning? Try to put on your own clothes.

Reading

Look for our story videos on the main nursery page that you can watch together. We hope you like them.

As you read stories at home, talk about the characters and events in the story. Maybe see if you can guess what is going to happen next. Draw pictures of your favourite character or parts of the story.

Writing

Keep practising your sounds. We have learned s, a, t, p so far. Look for things in your home that start with each sound. Make a game of pairs where you match the sounds. Play I spy - I spy with my little eye, something beginning with...(a letter sound, not the letter name). Play a game called What's in the Box? Put a selection of items in a box that begin with two different letter sounds. You can work together to sort the items according to their initial sound.

Can you make a card for someone in your family? It could be an Easter card, a get well soon card or just to say you love them! Have a go at some writing inside (parents, please celebrate their marks and ask your child what they have written. You can write it out underneath to record it if you wish)

Maths

Practise counting forwards and backwards and writing numbers up to 10

Look for opportunities to count around the house – how many steps to the kitchen? Go on a number hunt – what numbers can you see around you?

Go on a shape hunt – how many different shapes can you see in your house?

Play the number game from the video on the nursery page.

Can you have a counting challenge with someone in your family? Count how many steps it takes to get from one side of the room to the other. Who takes more steps?

Understanding the World

Learn about Easter <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-qVW9ljhIU>

Can you remember why people celebrate Easter and tell someone else in your family about it? You could also make the Easter nest cakes from the video if you have the ingredients. Mix cornflakes or rice krispies with melted chocolate and put into cupcake cases to make the nests. You can add mini eggs on the top - yummy!

Expressive Arts and Design

Use a potato to make an Easter egg printed picture. Ask a grown up to cut a potato in half. Dip it carefully into paint and then press it onto some paper to make the egg shape.



If you have a potato masher at home you could also use this for printing and make Easter egg shapes to cut out for an egg hunt. Can you hide your eggs around your house for someone else to find?



Dance and Music

Learn and practise nursery rhymes, for example Five Little Ducks, Mary had a Little Lamb.
