Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Did you notice how important the mouse was in the story even though he was very small. When everybody worked together they managed to pull up the turnip? What do you think you could do to help your family so you're all working together? What about putting your toys away when you've finished playing with them or helping to make your bed?

What about going on an Animal Walk - take turns to choose an animal to be from the story. Can you walk on all fours like a Cat, (don't forget to stroke your whiskers) or scurry around like a mouse? Maybe you could add some more animals too.

Health and Self Care

Everyone in The Enormous Turnip did lots of pulling to help get the turnip out. There are lots of different ways of pulling, why don't you look around the house to see if you Can find different thing that Can be pulled or pushed, maybe start by looking at your toys. Also if you're wearing something with a Zip, you Could try fastening it and pulling it up.

Reading

Look for our story videos on the main nursery page that you Can watch together. We hope you like them.

As you read stories at home, talk about the Characters and events in the story. Maybe

see if you Can guess what is going to happen next. Draw pictures of your favourite CharaCter or parts of the story.

Writing

Keep practising your sounds. We have learned s, a, t, p so far. Look for things in your home that start with each sound. Make a game of pairs where you match the sounds. Play I spy - I spy with my little eye, something beginning with...(a letter sound, not the letter name). Play a game called What's in the Box? Put a selection of items in a box that begin with two different letter sounds. You can work together to sort the items according to their initial sound.

Sing along to the Jolly Phonics songs <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=jvAYUvQUrGo</u> Can you draw a character from the story? Maybe you could draw the turnip, remember it's a circle shape.

Have a go at some writing too (parents, please Celebrate their marks and ask your Child what they have written. You Can write it out underneath to record it if you wish)

Maths

Practise counting forwards and backwards and writing numbers up to 10 https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7D4K90i70BM

Look for opportunities to count around the house – how many steps to the kitchen? Go on a number hunt – what numbers Can you see around you?

The Enormous Turnip story is a good way to introduce numbers that tell you the position of something in a list eg 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th etc. So in the story the man was 1st, the wife was 2nd, the boy was 3rd, the girl 4th, the dog 5th, Cat 6th and the mouse was 7th and last. When you're watching the story you could talk about this and try and find some things at home that you Can order in this way.

Understanding the World

Watch Mr Bloom when he talks about how a turnip grows and how he manages to pull it out with his friends

Watch the vegetable song <u>https://www.youtube.Com/watch?v=RE5tvaveVak</u> and talk about which vegetables you eat. Why don't you count how many types of fruit and vegetables you eat each day. We're all supposed to eat at least 5 different kinds each day. Why don't you try a new vegetable this week and you can tell us about it when we phone you.

Expressive Arts and Design

Can you draw or paint your favourite vegetable? You could try some vegetable printing too if you have any spare. When you're eating your dinner you could rearrange the food to make it look like a face? Maybe you could take a photo and email it to us.

Dance and Music
