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Learning from home - Nursery

English Watch or read The Three Little Pigs. Draw a picture of the three pigs in their different houses. Talk about the characters in the story. Do you feel bad for the wolf at the end? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QLR2pLUsl-Y
Phonics Keep practising your sounds. We have learned s, a, t, p so far. Look for things in your home that start with each sound. Make a game of pairs where you match the sounds. Play I spy - I spy with my little eye, something beginning with...(a letter sound, not the letter name). Play a game called What's in the Box? Put a selection of items in a box that begin with two different letter sounds. You can work together to sort the items according to their initial sound. Nursery Rhymes Learn and practise nursery rhymes, for example Five Little Ducks, Mary had a Little Lamb. https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/curations/nursery-rhymes
Maths Practise counting forwards and backwards and writing numbers up to 10 https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7D4K9oi7oBM Look for opportunities to count around the house – how many steps to the kitchen? Go on a number hunt – what numbers can you see around you? Understanding the World Look for signs of Spring. Draw or paint a picture of spring flowers. Talk to your child about animals and their babies and learn some baby animal names eg a baby sheep is a lamb, a baby cow is a calf, a baby pig is a piglet, a baby horse is a foal.
Dough Disco Have a dough disco at home! Pop on some music and squish any dough you have! Art Enjoy drawing, painting and making at home. Collect boxes, bottles and other materials and build structures. Use shoe boxes to make homes for toys and imaginative worlds. Use old magazines to cut up and make pictures.
DT Use bricks or another strong item you have at home (tin cans work well) to build a brick house for the three little pigs. Can you make it really strong so the wolf can't blow it down. Use a hairdryer to test how strong the house is. If you can, collect sticks and build a stick house and perhaps grass (or straw if you can get it) for the straw house. Test these with the hairdryer too. What happens?
