Dress up as your favourite book character.

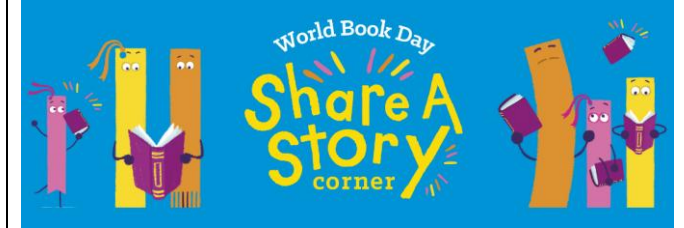

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Make some **story stones**! You'll need to collect some stones from outside and give them a good wash. Then use paint or permanent pens to draw some story characters or things onto each stone. You could even cut out pictures from a magazine and glue them on!

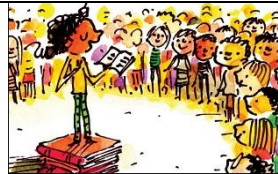
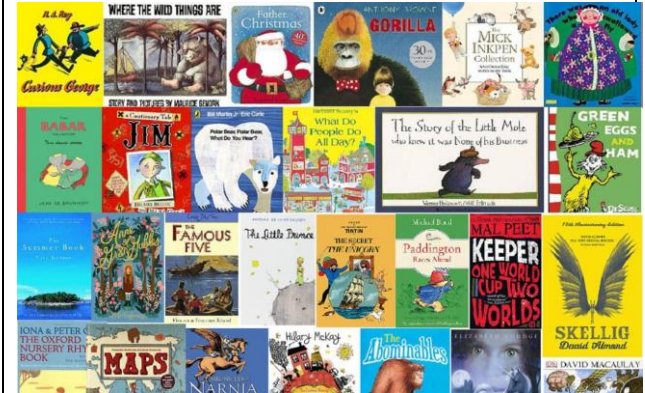


Make a new **book mark**!

Start with card, cut into a rectangle (you could even use recycled cardboard from around your house).

Then, decorate! You could use felt tips, pens or pencils to draw your favourite story characters, or get creative with glitter, paints, features or ribbon. You could also cut out pictures from a magazine or newspaper and stick them on! End by asking an adult to help you make a hole at the top and attaching some string or ribbon.

Design a new **book cover** for your favourite book. Include the title, author and your favourite image from the story – it could be a character, setting or scene.



Host a family **book reading!**

First, make some invitations to tell people where and when it will be. Make sure everyone chooses part of a favourite book or poem they'd like to read aloud. Decide on where you are going to host the event – make sure there's an area for people to reading and an area for people to listen. Then start the event: take turns sharing your favourite writing with each other!
