There is a little reading warm up at the beginning, then pause the video to read the sentences yourself.


Read this week's poem - Brown Bear







For example; How many sweeties do you have? Great, 5. If you take 3 away and eat them, how


many do you have left?

# Understanding the World

There are so many cool animals that live in the UK and Europe. Here are some you might be interested in and tell me if you find out about any other animals.

# Top Predators

Europe's top predators are bears, wolves, lynxes and wolverines.

There are a lot of very exciting articles online about how, beating many odds, wolves, bears and lynx numbers are on the rise. People are doing a lot to protect and help them.



#### Brown Bears

Brown bears have a long thick coat that keeps them warm.

They are omnivores. This means they eat plants and animals. They like to eat insects, especially moths. They spend most of their time looking for berries, leaves and insects to eat.


They can live for 20 to 30 years.

# Iberian Lynx

The Iberian lynx lives in Spain and were almost extinct, with less than 100 left. Extinct means something has all died. People have been working really hard to help them and now there are many more in the wild. People have been helping baby lynx to grow strong and healthy and then will release them into the wild.

Iberian lynx like to eat rabbits and rabbits often like to eat plants that grow close to busy roads. They have to be careful of cars! Can you design a way for a lynx to safely cross roads?

You could draw or make something.





## Beavers

Beavers have been reintroduced into the UK and many countries in Europe.

Reintroduced means they once lived here and now people have been bringing them back to live here again.

Did you know beavers can hold their breath for 15 minutes?! They are rodents, like rats and mice, but much larger.
