Key Words	
Habitat	Where they live.
Diet	What they eat.
Appearance	What they look like.
	They might have fur, hair, scales, feathers, a beak or claws.
Atlas	A book of maps.
Mammal	A warm blooded animal that has fur or hair and has babies. Mammals feed their babies milk.
Reptile	Cold blooded animals that have dry scaly skin, called scales or plates and they lay eggs.
Birds	Lay eggs and have feathers, wings and a beak. Normally they can fly.
Fiction	Something told or written that is not a fact.
Non-fiction	Something that is fact. It is true.

Invertebrates and amphibians will come up later in the curriculum, but by all means learn about these animals if your child is interested.
