To the tune of *Row, Row, Row Your Boat*

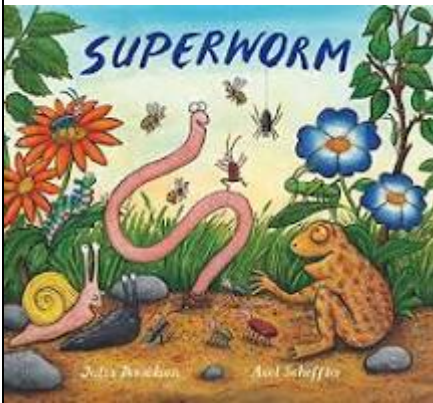
Wiggle, wiggle, wiggle worm

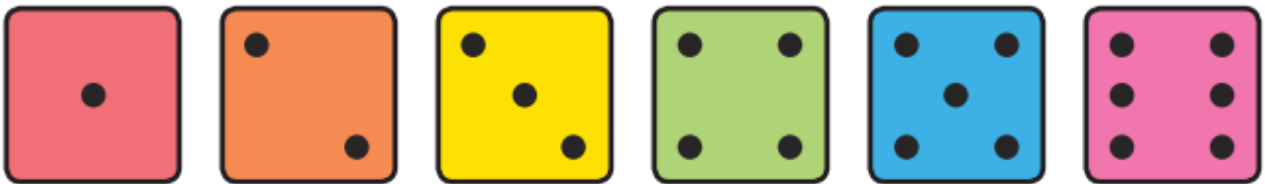

Maths

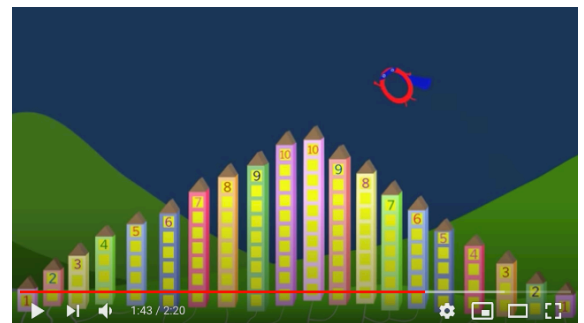
This week, focus on ordering numbers. Can you order numbers 1-10? 1-20? Some of you might even want to work with bigger numbers. Challenge yourself.

Non Cook Play Dough Recipe

2 cups flour

2 tablespoons vegetable oil (baby oil and coconut oil work too)

1/2 cup salt

2 tablespoons cream of tartar

1 1/2 cups boiling water

Food colouring (optional)

Mix in a bowl then knead together.

Keep in an airtight container.

Understanding the World

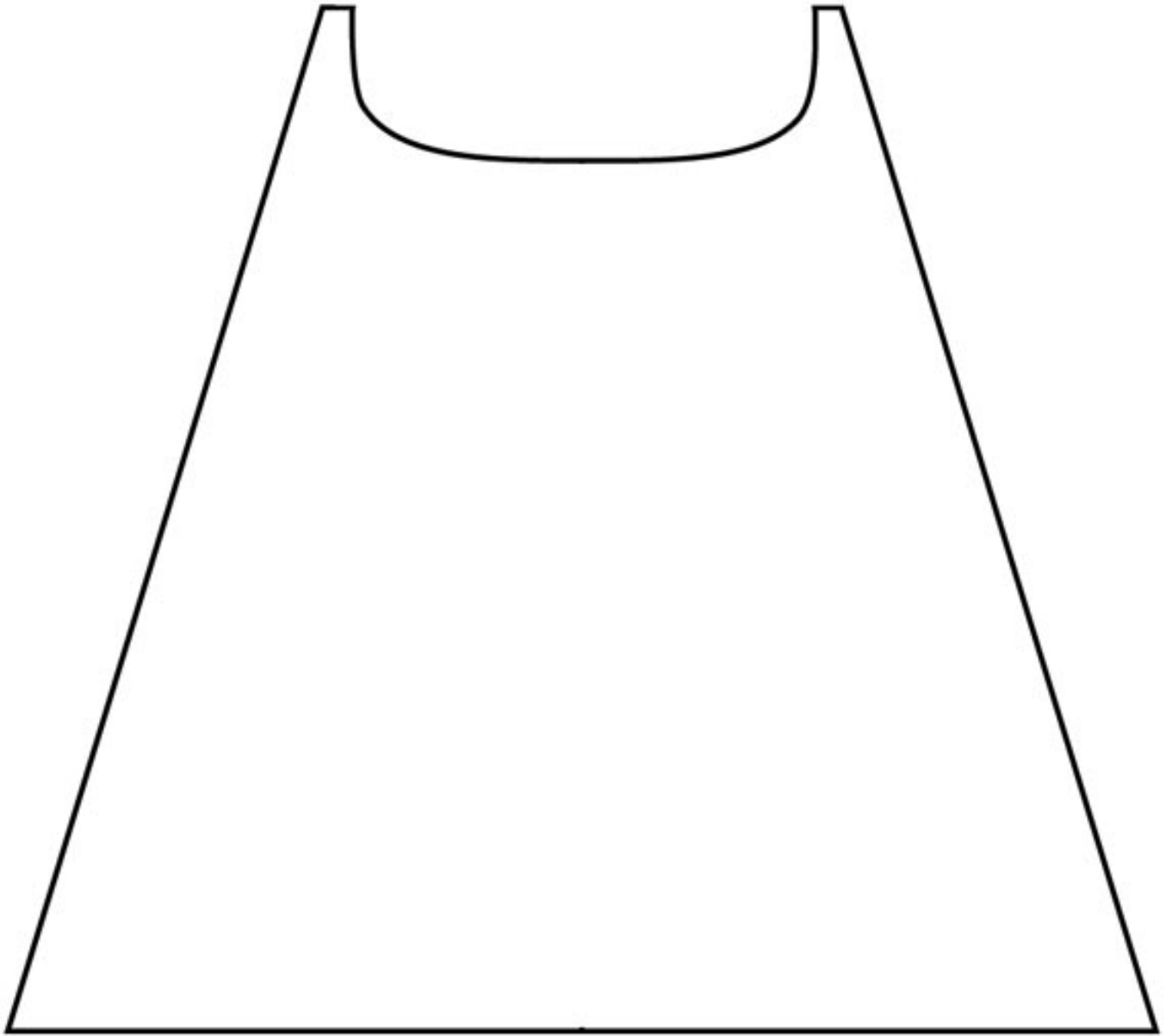
