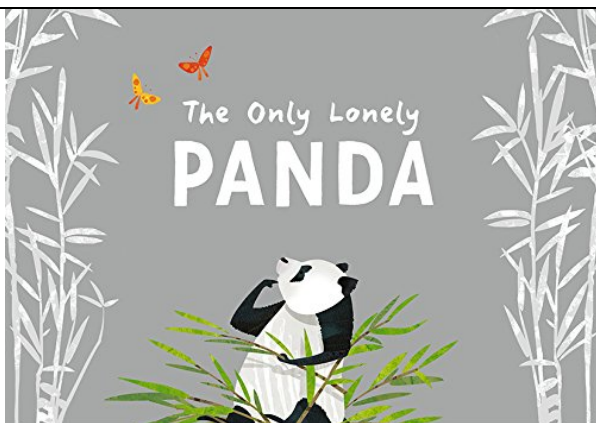


### Writing

There are two ebooks to read this week – *My Baby Sister* and *Come Stay with Me*.

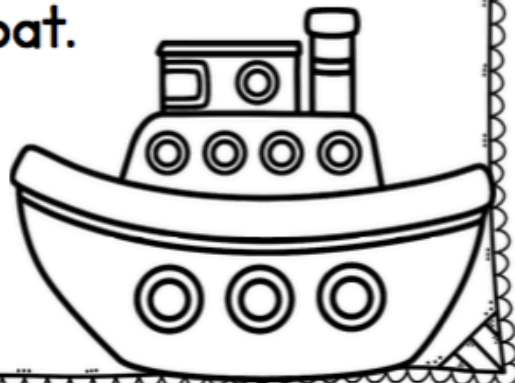

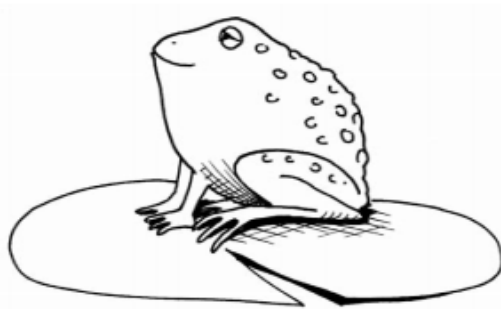

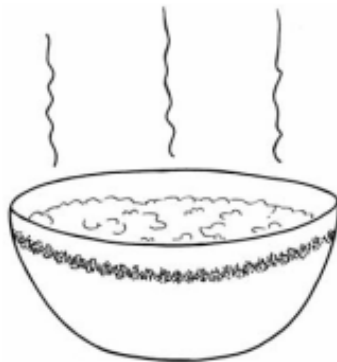

# Oat Biscuits Recipe

75g wholemeal flour

1 tsp baking powder

75g porridge oats

50g caster sugar

75g butter

1 tbsp golden syrup

2 tbsp milk

**1.** Heat the oven to 180C/fan 160C/gas 4. Line a **baking tray** with baking parchment.

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**2.** Sift flour into a **bowl**. Mix in baking powder, porridge oats and sugar.

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**3.** Melt the butter, syrup and milk in a small saucepan or in the microwave and stir.

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**4.** Add to the dry ingredients. Mix until the liquid covers all the oat mixture and until well combined.

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**5.** Spoon onto a baking tray and shape into rounds, leaving space between each biscuit as they will spread whilst cooking.

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**6.** Bake for 10 to 15 mins, or until golden brown. Leave to cool for 5 mins before removing from tray.

# Oat Smoothie Recipe



## Ingredients

1 banana

1 tbsp porridge oats

80g soft fruit (whatever you have – strawberries, blueberries, and mango all work well)

150ml milk

1 tsp honey

1 tsp vanilla extract

## Method

**1.** Put all the ingredients in a **blender** and whizz for 1 min until smooth.

**2.** Pour the banana oat smoothie into two glasses to serve.

## Maths

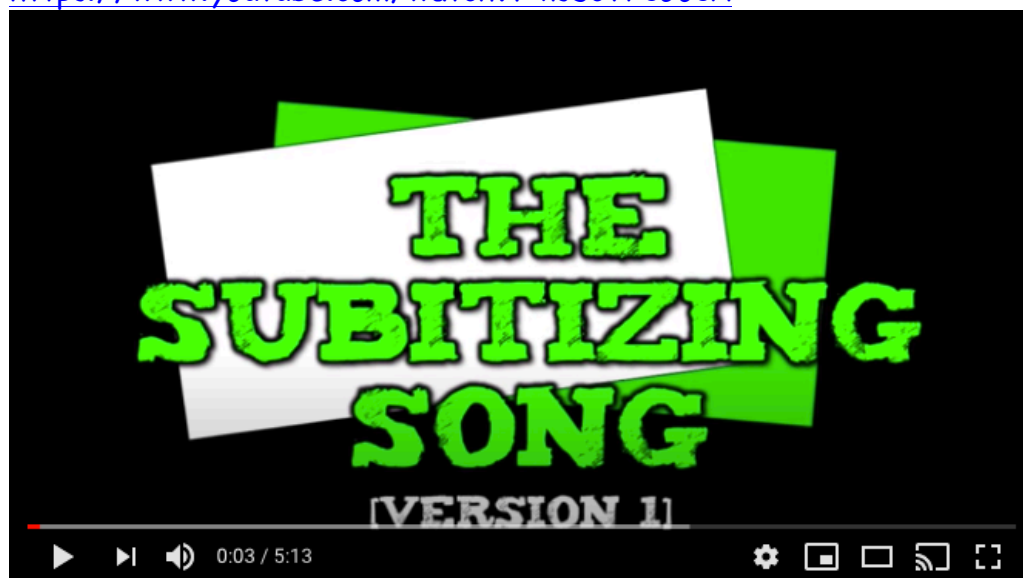
This week practise subitizing.

Subitizing is being able to instantly recognise how many objects there are in a set without having to count them. This is an important skill for beginner mathematicians.

Help them look at a set and quickly think how many there are.

4. They live in China.



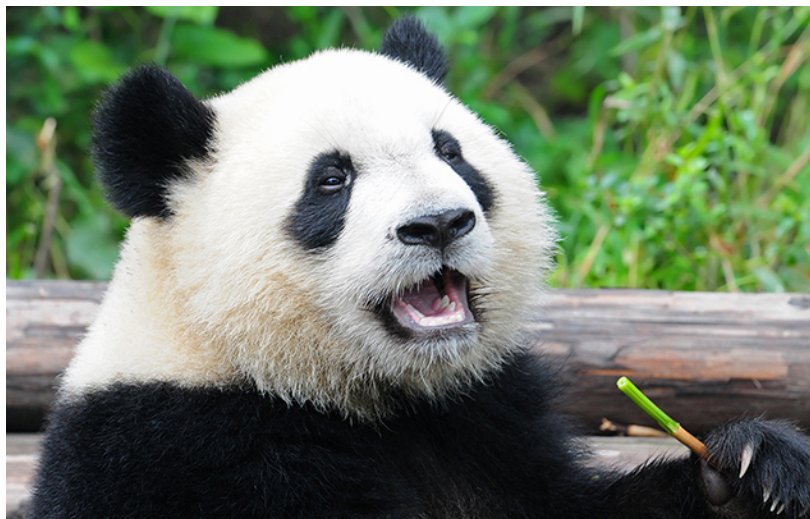
5. Baby pandas are born pink and are about the length of a pencil.

What is your favourite animal that is black and white? Use black and white materials to make a picture of it. Charcoal is fun to use if you can get your hands on some.



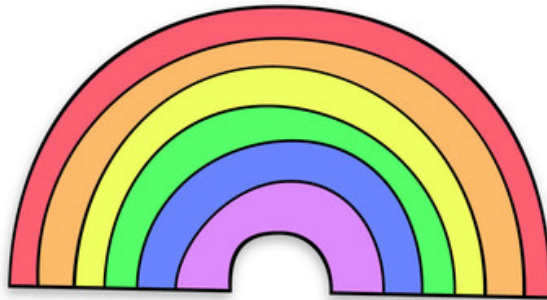




## Class Photo
