




Science: Recycling




Now, you are going on a **Recycling Hunt!** Take a **look at/in your recycling bin/s** and **think about these questions** (maybe you can discuss them with your adult or your brother or sister?) What different **items** do we recycle? What **materials** are those items made from? (eg: plastic, paper, glass etc.) Do you have different recycling bins for products made from different materials? (eg: a box for products made from plastic like water bottles or a box for items made from metal, like tins of soup). **You can write and/or draw some answers to these questions below.**



Now choose **FIVE** of the recycled items from your Recycling Hunt above and **sort them into the table below**. **Draw and write the name of the item** and then say what **material** it is made from (eg: plastic, paper, cardboard, metal etc.)
