

Look also at what the different drummers are <u>wearing</u> and what <u>their drum kits look</u> like. I've given you their names and some <u>hints</u> with each picture. <u>Number the pictures 1-4</u>, with 1 being the drummer you think came <u>FIRST</u> in History and 4 being the drummer you think is still drumming <u>TODAY</u>.
