

Monster Monday Challenge

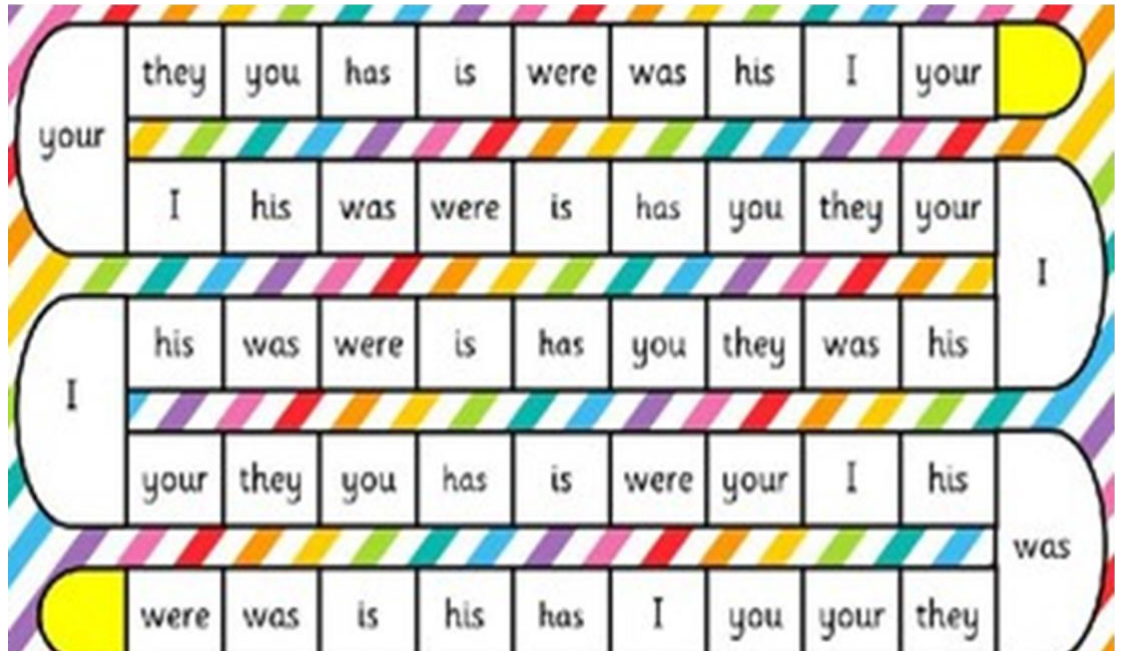
Choose a Phonics Game (or more than one!) from **Phonics Play** or **Busy Things** (Phase 4 and Phase 5, including our Tricky Words).

If you don't have a dice, you can use a coin or a counter of some sort and simply roll it onto the board and read the word it lands on. Happy Rolling and Reading!









Take a Bonus Point if you put the word into a Sassy Sentence!
