

This week we are going to learn about the <u>Amazing Rosa</u>


<u>Parks</u>. Rosa believed strongly that <u>all people should be</u>



Tuesday 30th June 2020 LO: I can ask a question to an historical figure




If you could ask Rosa Parks a question, what question would you ask her? Why?


