As always, I'm really looking forward to seeing your wonderful learning!

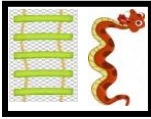
You're putting in lots of effort and I am super proud of you all!

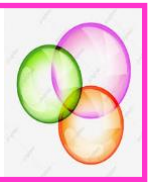
English
