


Earthquakes



- 1. An earthquake is a sudden violent shaking of the ground.
- 2. **Tectonic plates** are pieces of the earth's crust and upper mantle. Earthquakes usually occur on **plate boundaries**.
- 3. Earthquakes are measured on the Richter scale.

Volcanoes

 A volcano is a mountain or hill, typically conical, having a crater or vent through which lava, rock fragments, hot vapour, and gas are or have been erupted from the earth's crust



2. Geologists classify volcanoes into three types: **composite volcanoes**, **cinder cone volcanoes** and **shield volcanoes**.
