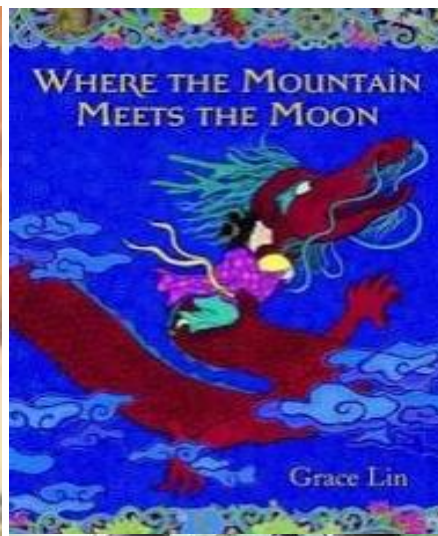
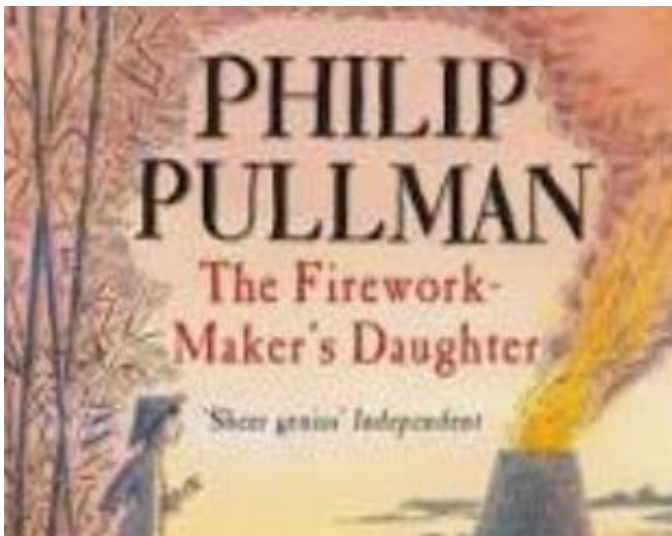

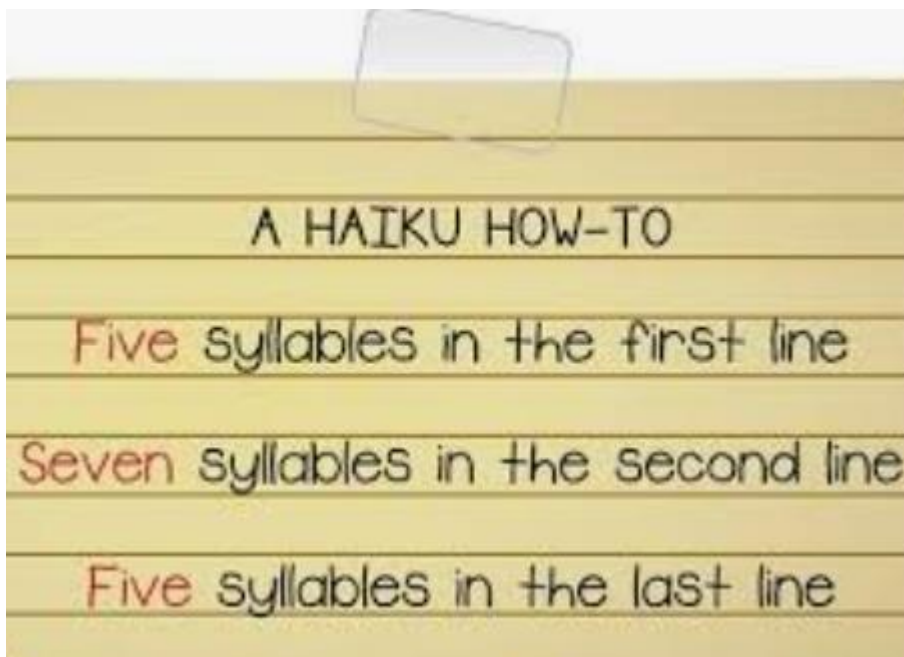

Spicy – write out the story in your own words

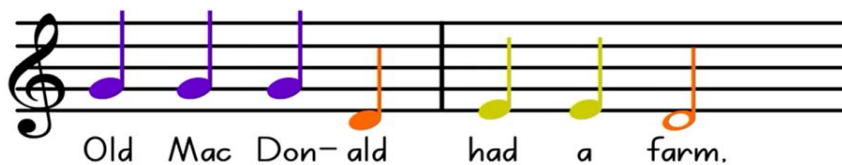

Science 7.1.21

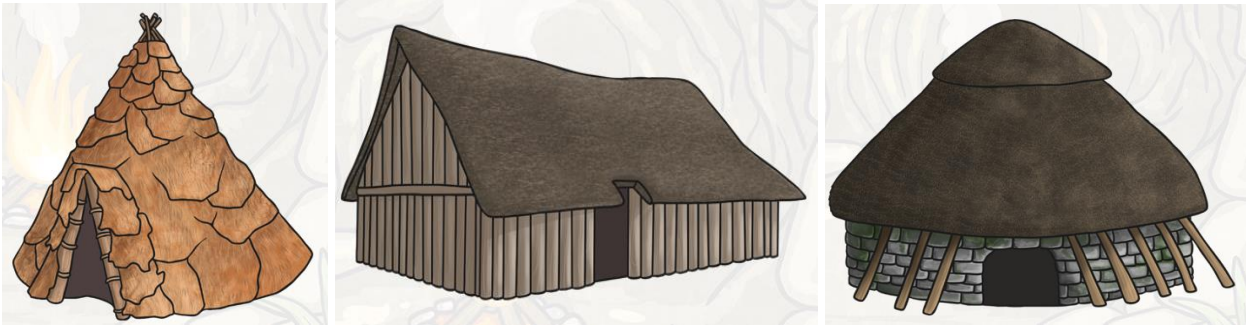


This week, you are going to compare how things move on different surfaces.
