

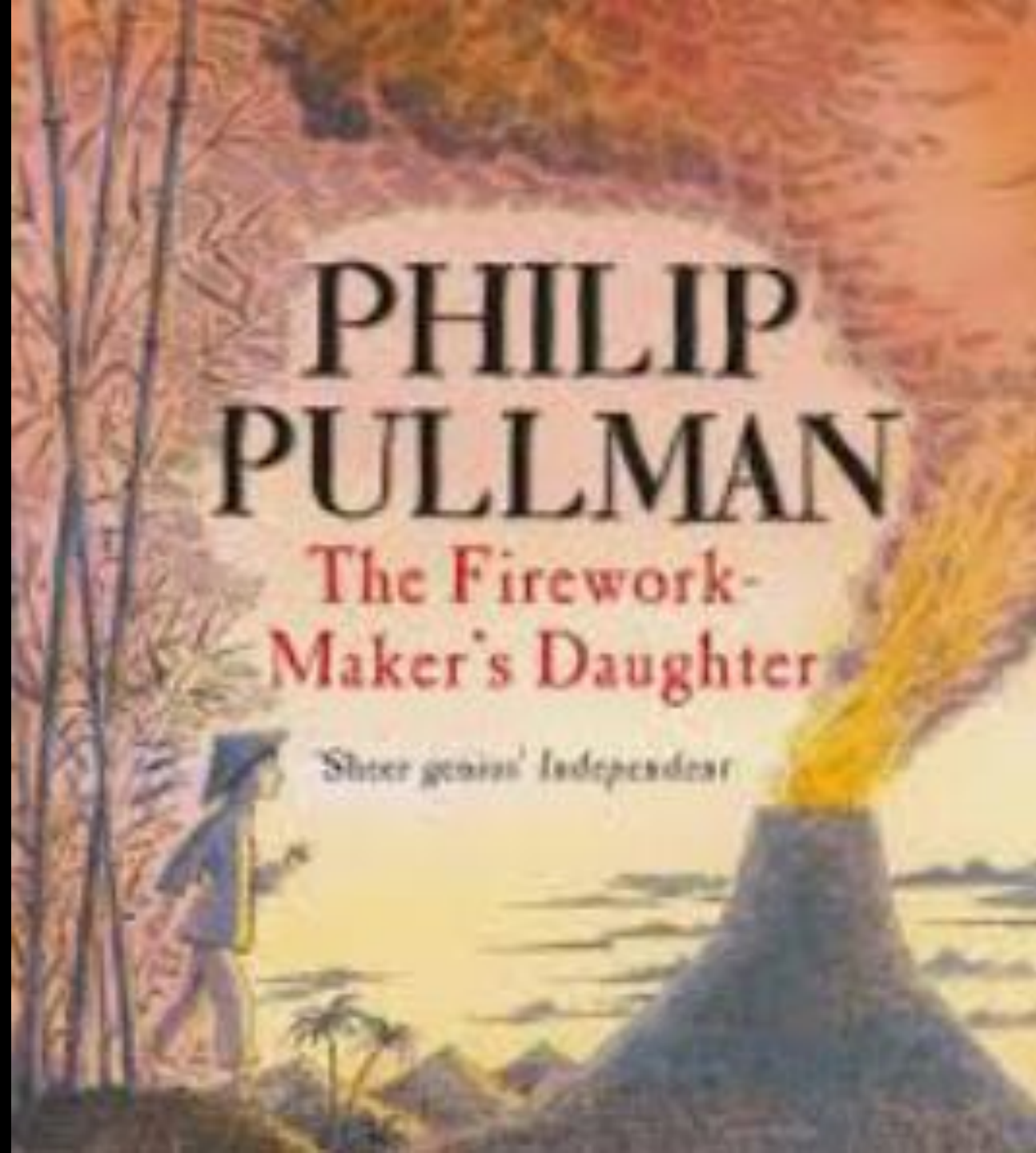

Today, we are going to use the senses grid you did yesterday to write a setting description.

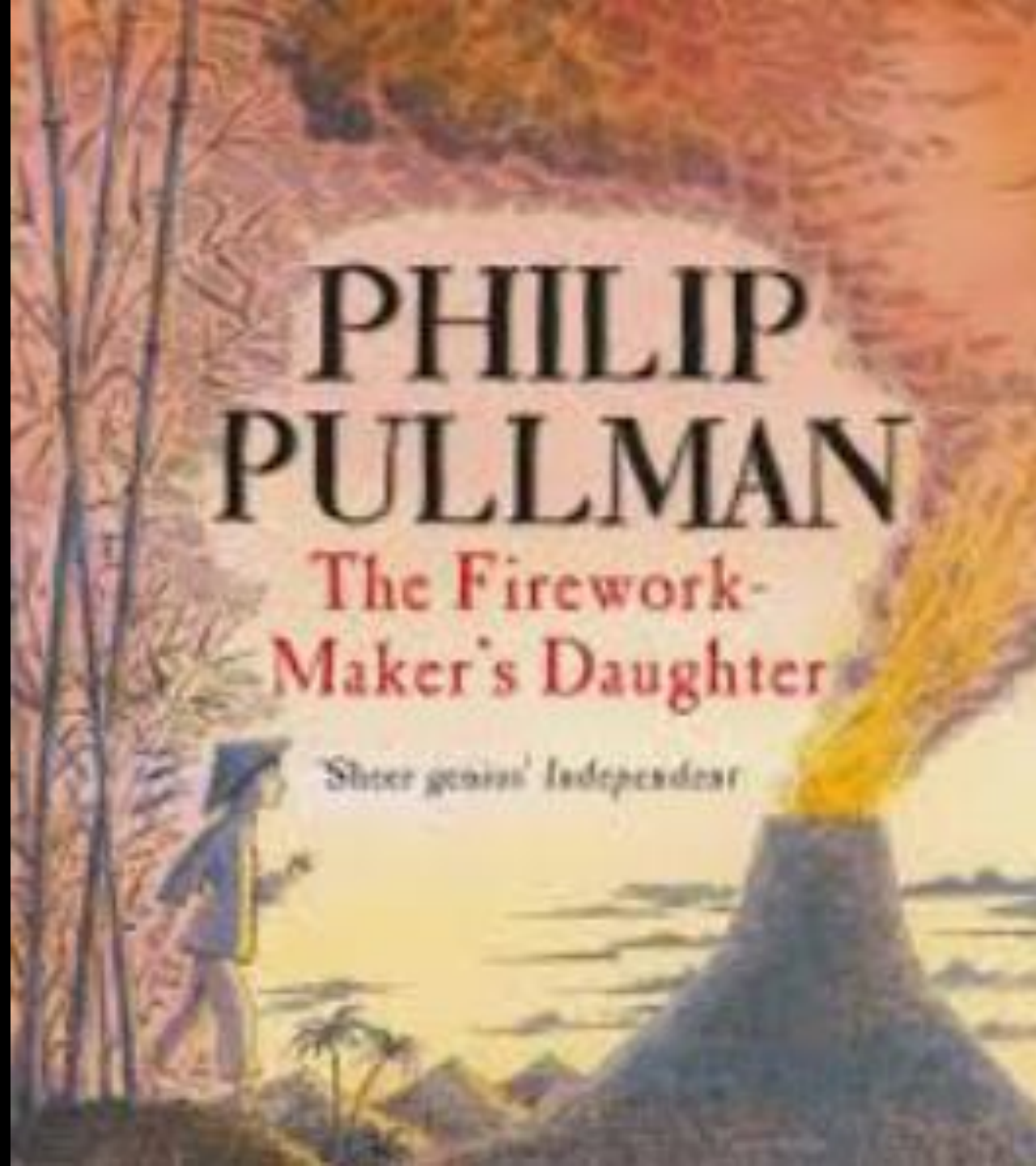


Example:

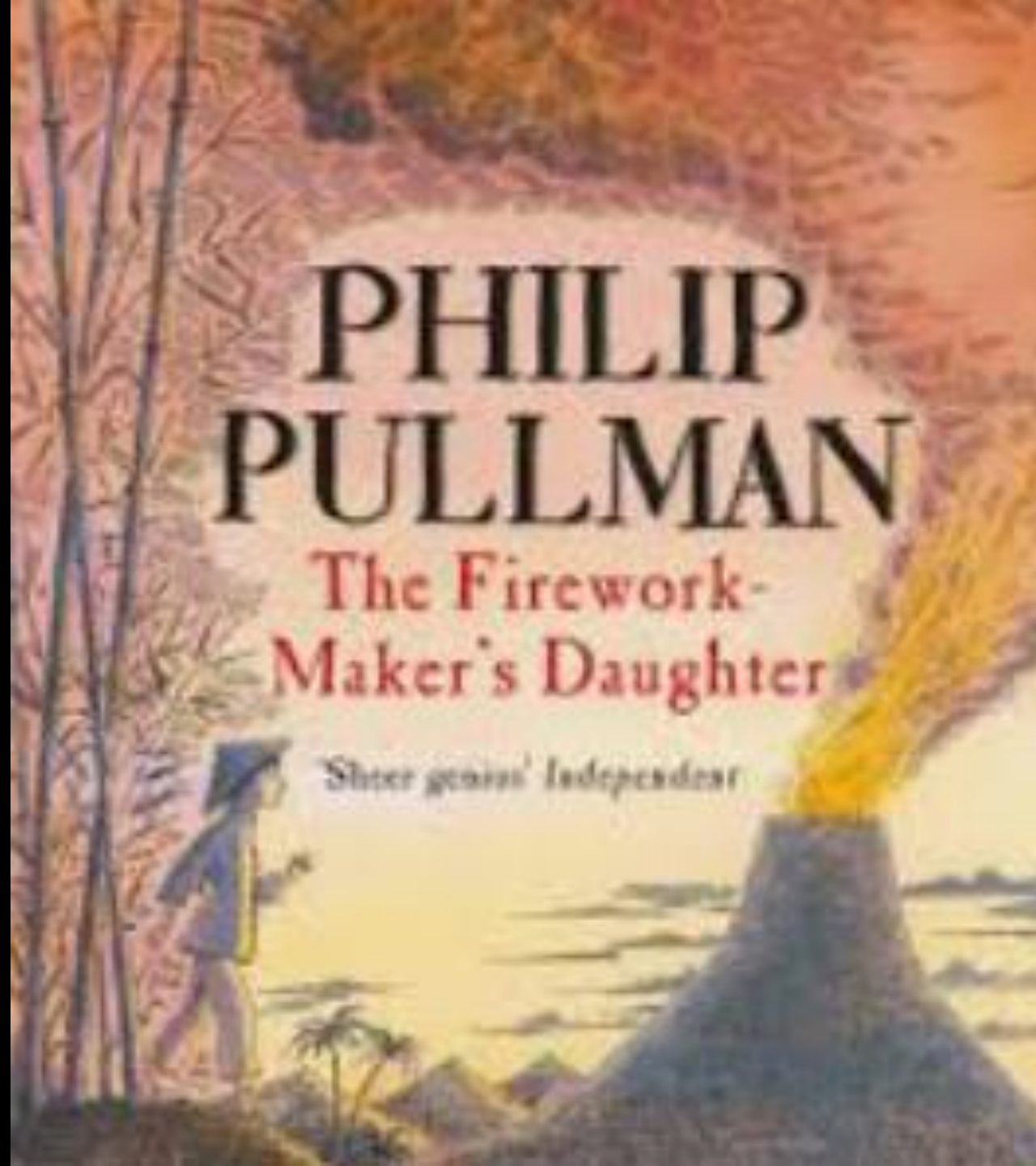
The moist soil squelched below Lila's feet. Copper snakes occasionally littered the path. They lay curled and flat – it seemed possible to mistake them for gigantic coins.

In amongst the leaves...

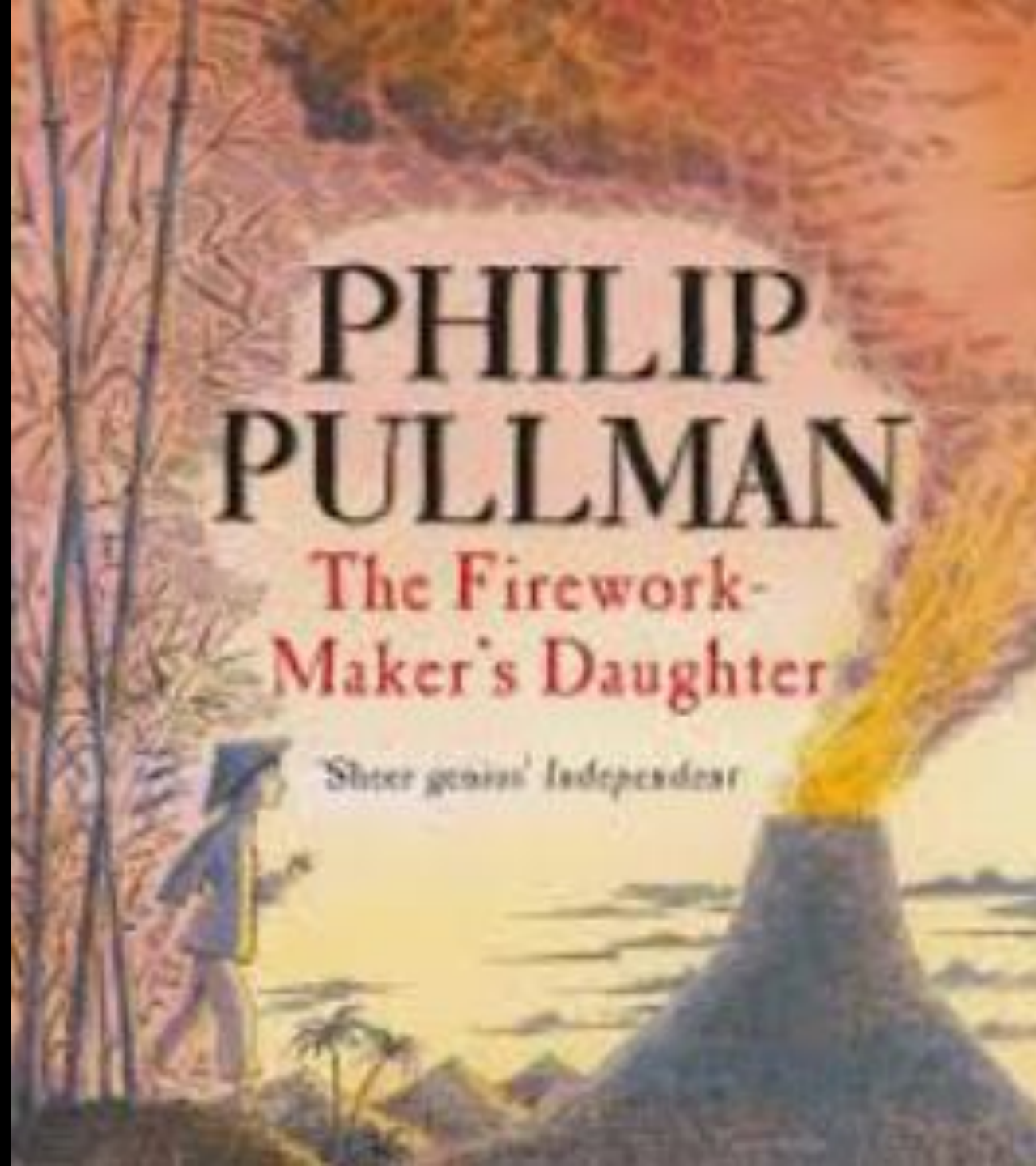
Spicy – Vocabulary to include:
