1/12/20 – L.O: I can retell a story

You do not have to finish it today – tomorrow is a reading task, so you may want to start today and finish tomorrow.

Design a poster telling me about them. Include:





ART - 2/12/20


This week, we are going to continue with the Mosaic Project that we had the workshop on last week!

Your design may be selected to be part of the school mosaic!


