7/12/20 – L.O: I can describe a setting

8/12/20 – L.O: I can plan a myth

Use the 'English Task 8.12.20' to plan your myth. Pick one Spice Level and complete it. Think about:

-**How it starts** (introducing your hero/heroine)

-**The build-up** (What does your hero/heroine want? DO they decide to travel somewhere? This is probably where you will describe your setting!)

-**The problem** (your hero/heroine meets the monster)

-**The resolution** (how is your story resolved? Does your hero/heroine kill the monster? Make friends (befriend) with them? Travel with them? It's up to you!

-**The ending** – how will you finish your story?

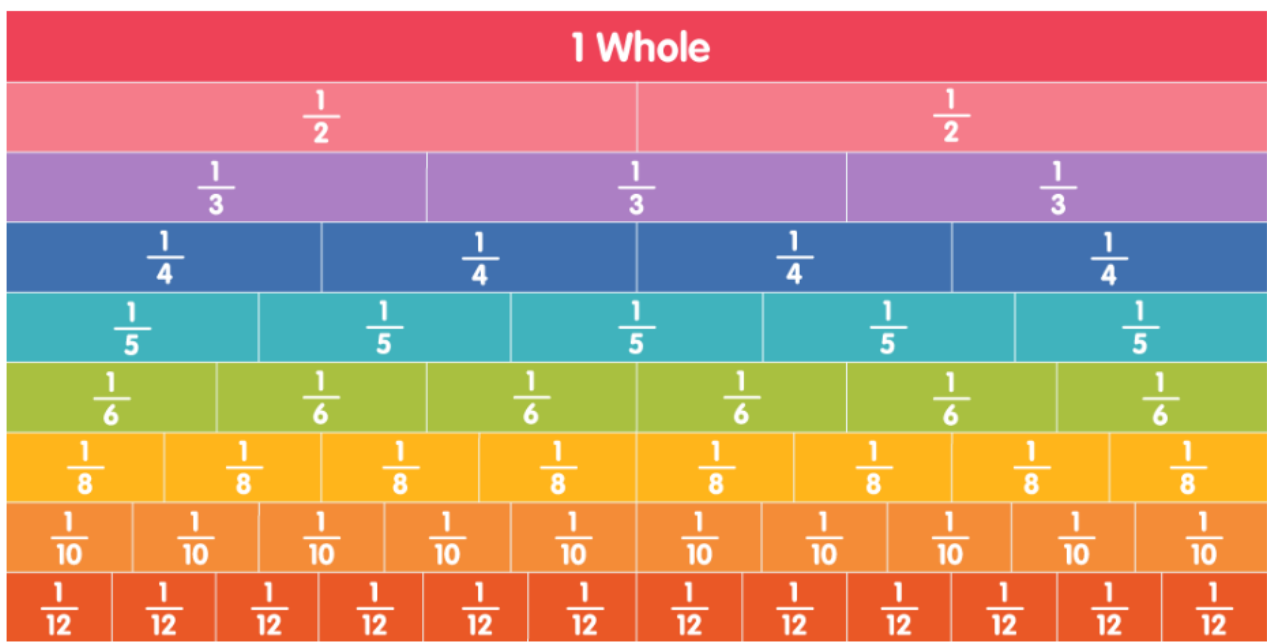
