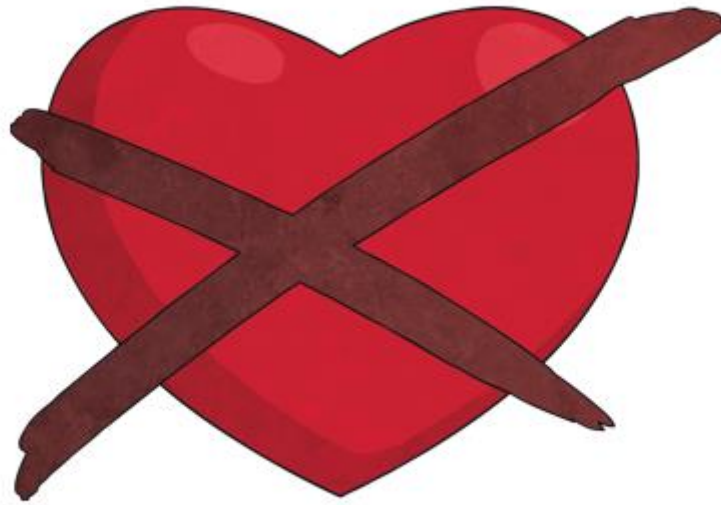

parce que

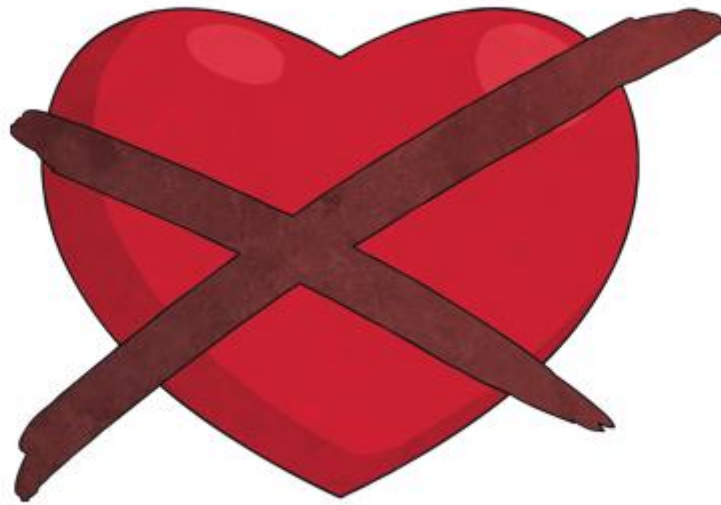
it's very creamy.



c'est très crémeux.

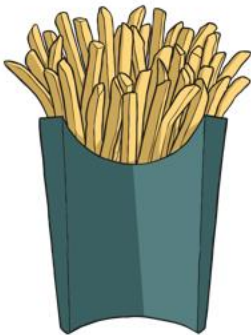
(say tray crem-eur)
