- 4. Max says 'In a way, Mr Gravis was also like a puzzle that needed to be solved'. What do you think he means by this? What might he do to help?
- 5. Why do you think Max felt a little bit guilty when his parents got home?
- 6. The next day, Max is feeling bad. Do you think he should still make Walter do his chores? Why/ why not?
- 7. Look at the paragraph 'All mixed up'. How can Max tell that there is something wrong with Walter?
- 8. Why does Max feel sad when he thinks about taking Walter apart?
- 9. Prediction: What do you think Max's idea is when he sees the chess piece in Walter's hand?
- 10. How do you think Mr Gravis felt when he first saw Walter? How about after he'd played chess with him?
- 11. Was the chess game with Mr Gravis a success? How do you know?
- 12. Do you think Max was right to give Walter to Mr Gravis? Or should he have kept him to do his chores? Explain your answer.
