



## Key historical people: Jane Austen

- born 1775
- died 1817 (aged 41)
- English novelist (writer)
- Most famous for 4 novels: Sense and Sensibility, Pride and Prejudice, Mansfield Park, Emma.
- Her father was a church minister.
- She had six brothers and one sister
- Her family was very close and they all loved acting
- She was especially close to her sister, Cassandra.
- She used her extended family and friends from her local area to give her ideas for the characters in her books
- She almost died of typhus
- In 1802 she agreed to marry a man but the next morning, she changed her mind

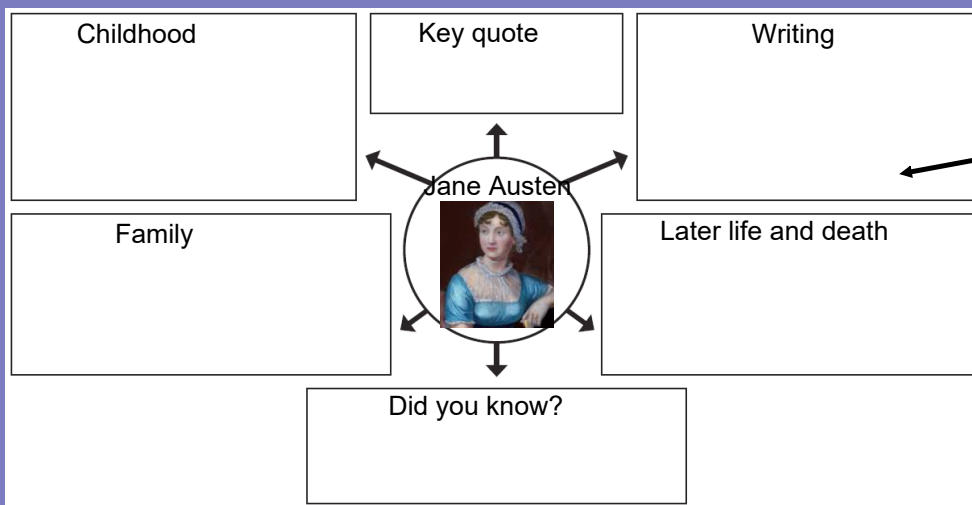
