Task: Redesign and change this area for the better. Things to think about:

- Does it look different in the winter?
- What is there now?
- Does any living thing use the space?
- Does it have any positive impact as it is now?
- Is there water nearby?
- Does it have sunlight or is it in the shade?

Focus: I can plan positive changes to a local environment and can explain how these changes will help living things within the area. Draw a birds-eye view of the area. Think about how to change the space to make it better and add these details to your own plan. Label your plan, and write brief notes about why you are making.

- What will you need to have there for living things to use it? (hedgehogs will need slugs and snails, which need plants; bees will need flowering plants)
- Try to think of 5 different living things that might use the space and how they might use it.
