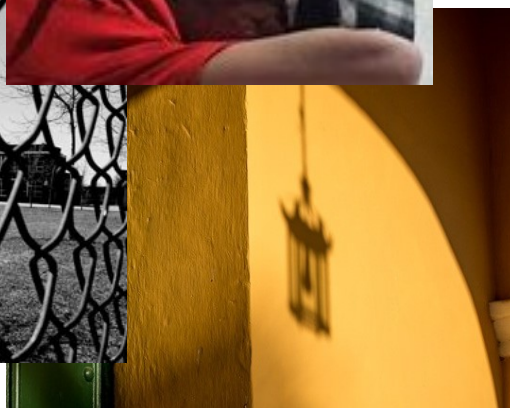


Year 5 Photography / Art project

Be creative - think about:

- ◆ Different angles and view points— it doesn't need to be straight on; try the view from above / below / the side
- ◆ Lighting—bright or dark, harsh or soft, silhouette, shadows...
- ◆ Focus—you could zoom in on an element of the object for more detail / a different view of it
- ◆ Positioning—will the subject be in the middle, at the top, bottom, to one side
- ◆ Colour— natural, black and white, sepia, filters
