## Learning from home – Year 5 – W.B. 20<sup>th</sup> April

Below is a list of tasks and activities to work on over this week. Your child should be able to work on these tasks mostly independently, although it's always nice for them to discuss their ideas and share what they've achieved with someone. We do not expect every single task to be completed, rather it is a list of ideas to keep them busy and learning, in line with the National Curriculum. Whilst it is important to keep learning key facts, knowledge and skills this is also a great opportunity for your child to explore their interests further and be creative. Please share a sample of their learning with us every week – a piece of English, Maths and perhaps another piece they are very proud of – by emailing it to [admin@fleet.camden.sch.uk](mailto:admin@fleet.camden.sch.uk) with the class teacher's name as the subject.

### English

**Reading:** Do the reading task set for your reading group. Read the text and answer the questions on paper (links on Fleet website -

**Writing:** Use the information from the reading tasks and your own research to create a fact file about **Valentina Tereshkova – The First Woman in Space**. You could handwrite this, type it up in a Word document or do it as a PowerPoint. Feel free to add pictures.

I would recommend breaking this task down and doing it over a few days – Day 1: research and recording facts.

Day 2 & 3: writing up the facts into interesting paragraphs (following the headings below). Day 4: Editing.

### Key headings:

- Childhood/early life – family, where she grew up, rich/poor
- Training/career – education, what did she study, jobs
- In Space! – When and why did she go into space? For how long? In what? What was it like?

- **Later life – Achievements, work/life after being in space**

Even though it's a fact file, you can still use interesting adjectives, verbs and noun phrases in your writing. Remember to vary your sentence structures too!

CHALLENGE: Use parenthesis to add in extra information – we learnt this in school!

E.g. instead of 'Valentina was on her own in the shuttle when it was orbiting the Earth.' Make it more interesting like this 'The brave cosmonaut (Russian term for astronaut) was completely alone in the shuttle, so unfortunately she had no one to share her amazing experience of orbiting Earth with.'

**Spellings this week:** The suffix '-able'. See document on Year 5 home learning page for spelling list and activities.

**Maths: This week's focus – decimal fractions.**
