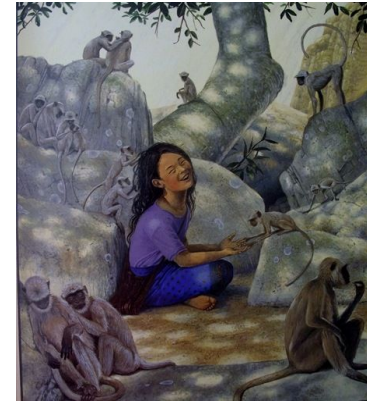
The monkeys dashed through the emerald green tea bushes.
