Human features: Something which is made by humans e.g. buildings, roads

# These are political maps. What do they show us?

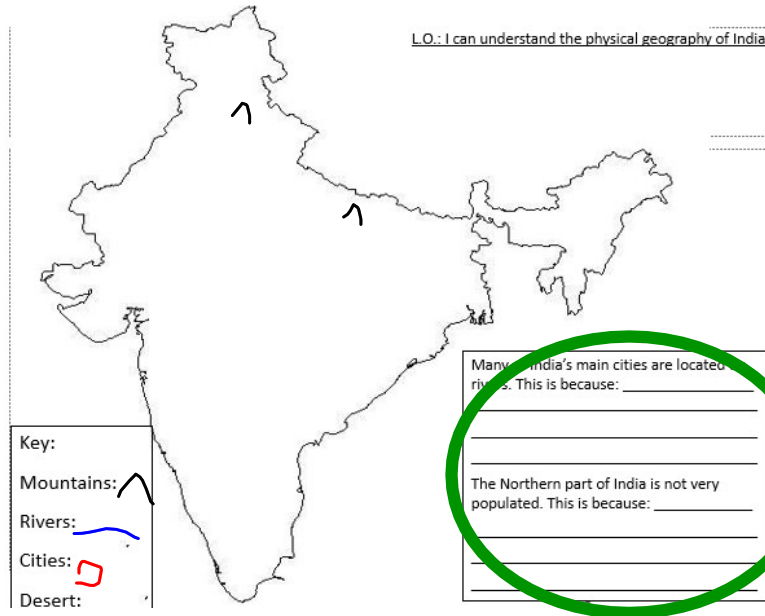




What features can you see?
