R.E: Continuing with our learning about Judaism, we are going to learn about the story behind Passover. **Read the information on this page:**



Summary: The Pharaoh was persecuting the Jews (Israelites). Moses asked him to set them free, but the Pharaoh refused. God sent 10 plagues to Egypt to punish the Egyptian people, the last was the Angel of Death. The Israelites marked their homes so that the Angel of Death knew to 'pass over' their homes. That is why it is called Passover.

Now, there is a choice of 2 activities:

Option 1: Write a newspaper report detailing the ten plagues which God sent to Egypt.

Option 2: Divide your page up into ten sections. Draw a picture of and write about each of the ten plagues – 1 in each section. Clicking on the words in this section (found on the above webpage) will give you all the information you need.
