Fact 3: Jupiter has 39 moons.



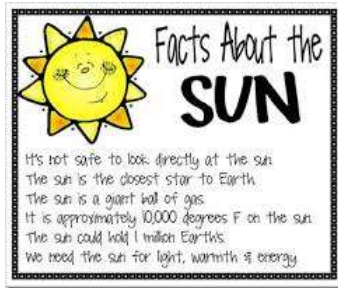
