Science: Task 1- Knowledge Harvest

Then in write down around the title any facts or key words you know that are related to Electricity. In one coloured pencil, please write down at least 3 questions you have about Electricity.

Task 2- Research

Use the PDF's on Thomas Edison and Michael Faraday and any google searches or books you may have access to, to create research notes on these key historical figures linked to our Science Topic. You need to collect the following information:

- Name
- Where and when they were born/died
- What their life was like
- Significant achievements

You can record your notes in bullet points or in a short paragraph. You can also add information with drawn pictures. You can do this on a laptop if you prefer.

<u>PSHE</u>: A new year can be a great time to think about personal goals. At the moment it can feel like we are restricted in lots of areas of our lives but it is important to recognise that we can make still a positive impact in ours and others lives.
